Big Brothers Big Sisters of Coastal & Northern New Jersey (BBBSCNNJ) has been selected as a LGBTQ+ Peer Coach for agencies within the national federation of Big Brothers Big Sisters of America (BBBSA). The peer coaching program invites agencies from around the country to connect with BBBSCNNJ for guidance and advice in developing programs, staff, and volunteers to better support and serve the LGBTQ+ community.

The committee meets quarterly with the goal of ensuring that the agency is keeping DEI at the forefront of all operations, specifically in three areas: recruitment, training and program initiatives.

In the 47 years of BBBSCNNJ's operations in New Jersey, the mentoring programs have always welcomed all, including Bigs, Littles and their parents/guardians of every gender, gender identity, gender expression, or sexual orientation.
